Plitvice lakes consists of sixteen interlink lakes, connected by a series of breathtaking waterfalls. The lake system is divided into the upper lakes and the lower lakes. The upper lakes, surrounded by thick forests and interlinked by numerous waterfalls, lie in a dolomite valley, while the lower lakes, smaller and shallower, surrounded only by sparse underbrush, lie on the limestone bedrock.</p>
